## From testing to release

**Here's what has happened in the last few months in the In-DigiT project and what's to come!**

The project **Training Toolkit** has entered the final phase: last adjustments, and upcoming release on the project website!

- **DIGITAL TRAINING COURSE - FINAL STRETCH**

The "**Inclusive and Responsible Digitalisation in Training**" course is on the home stretch.

The course covers **10 training modules** - including an Introduction, Regulations, an in-depth look at the 7 responsible digital qualities, and a Synthesis - delivered through audio podcasts, micro-learning videos, and PDF learning materials, **in all the partners' languages**.

The official release is planned for early June 2026, and all modules will be freely accessible via the project website and this website:

But that's not all: the two digital escape games are almost ready too!

- **DIGITAL ESCAPE GAMES**

Our two digital escape games - **The clockwork city** and **The time-travelling hackers** - have successfully completed their internal testing phase!

All partner organisations participated in the review, collecting valuable feedback that has been incorporated into the final versions.

Translations of both games into all 5 project languages (English, French, Greek, Bulgarian, and Italian) will soon be available, allowing players from all partner countries to enjoy the experience in their own language!

## PARTNERSHIP MEETING IN ROME, ITALY!

On 7 and 8 May, the In-DigiT consortium met in Rome for the project's third and final meeting.

The partners worked on finalising the last two results and discussed the final phase of the project, focusing on dissemination activities and the organisation of the **final events in each partner country**: France, Belgium, Greece, Bulgaria, and Italy.
