Over the last few weeks, all In-DigiT partners have **successfully organised their national final events**, presenting the project's results to educators, trainers, training organisations, IT professionals and education stakeholders.

Across the five partner countries, the events brought together **more than 200** participants, creating opportunities to discuss responsible digitalisation, accessibility, sustainability and inclusion in education.

Participants explored the project's resources through demonstrations, interactive sessions and discussions on how **responsible digital practices** can support more inclusive and environmentally sustainable learning.

Looking back on two years of collaboration, it has been an **inspiring journey**.

The In-DigiT partnership has worked together to **support a more responsible approach to digital education** by developing practical resources that help educators and training organisations make digital learning **more inclusive, sustainable, accessible, responsible**.
